Pill Box Set-Up & Medication Reconciliation

Nurse will come to your home to set up all of your medications in your pill boxes by day, and time of day to ensure you are not skipping any doses, and you are taking all prescribed and over the counter medications. Nurse will review your existing medication orders to ensure nothing is missing or added.



Medication Management \$200.00/month

Nurse will come to your home to act as liaison to your pharmacy and physician to call in new medication orders and process all prescription renewals, perform overall medication monitoring, and manage medication changes. Nurse will assist you in scheduling follow up appointments with your Primary Care Physician as well as all other specialists as necessary.
